As a follow-up to the Canadian Woodlands Forum Fall Meeting 'From Seedling to Success', this one-day workshop will focus on practical approaches to stand tending in High Production Forestry (HPF) to maximize growth and yield. The morning session will open with an overview of Nova Scotia's plantation experience, including a discussion of common causes of failure and strategies to improve long-term outcomes.

Presentations will explore stand-tending strategies and key practices such as vegetation management, pre-commercial thinning, and commercial thinning.

In the afternoon, a field tour will provide participants with the opportunity to observe these practices in action and examine how they contribute to the successful establishment and development of high-yield forest stands.

Designed for practitioners, planners, and forestry professionals, the session will deliver practical insights and foster informed discussion on effective stand management in high-production forests.
